I just did my first run since becoming a Lary! 🙌 It's my first run in 10 months actually... Up until Christmas I'd been running with people from work down the canal at lunchtimes. Only about 5k but I was really starting to struggle. Not with my fitness, I knew my legs had it in them, I just couldn't breathe properly and thought it was just a case of getting what the doctors thought was some asthma under control. I had this niggle that I couldn't shake that something wasn't right though. Inhalers weren't working and I couldn't speak a sentence without pausing for breath. Countless trips back and forth to the GP's and hospital referrals eventually uncovered the real reason. Quite a sizeable tumour 4.3cm by 2.5x2.3cm obstructing my airway!! When the ENT doctor put a camera down my throat it

showed my airway had narrowed to approx 2mm wide which explains why I could hardly breathe. It felt good to get out & run this morning, the first 5 mins I was just getting used to running with a new way of breathing but the difference was I could actually breathe!!! Only did about 4km this morning but it's a start! 🙌 Well done Tanja, we are all proud of you – what a fantastic personal achievement!
